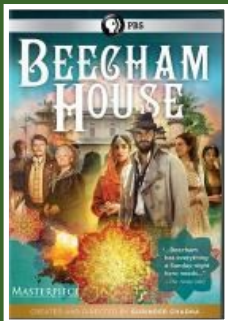

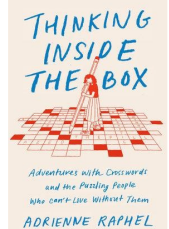

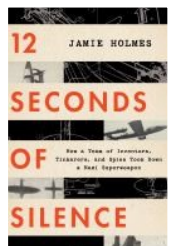
THE EIGHTH DETECTIVE BY ALEX PAVESI

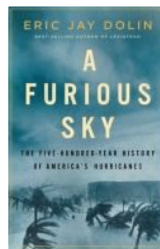
THE PULL OF THE STARS BY EMMA DONOGHUE

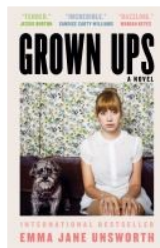

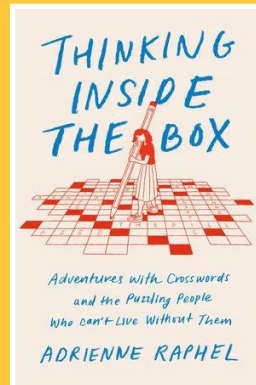

discusses her new book, *Thinking Inside the Box*, a delightful exploration of the crossword puzzle and its fascinating history.

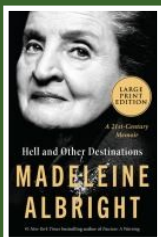
STORYTIME WITH MISS CHRISTINA

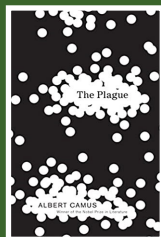

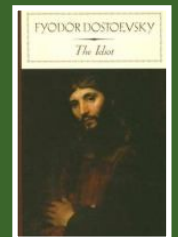
